Our facilities will be affordable and accessible to the community to support the goals of a healthier Ontario, a stronger community, and student success.

Community groups seeking the use of school facilities must obtain a permit. These permits are needed for the use of classrooms, gymnasiums, auditoriums, libraries, cafeterias etc. during non-school hours.
